iPad Basics: 2 Sessions

Prerequisite for all other iPad classes.

This 4-hour class is designed to launch first-time owners into a comfort zone with their iPads. You don't need any computer background in order to take this class. All you will need is your iPad, already registered and working. We'll cover the various parts of the iPad, what a user sees on the screen, how to use the basic hand gestures, and some of the applications. These include Email, Safari (surf the web), Maps, Settings, and Photos.



iPad Apps and Books: 3 sessions

Now that you have taken the iPad Basics class, the fun continues as you learn how to find, install, and update those apps that will make the iPad your personalized device. Besides the apps of your choice, we will specifically look at ebook reader apps including iBooks, Kindle, and Nook. Then we'll explore using both ebooks and audiobooks from your local library.



Photos on the iPad: 2 sessions

Explore the use of photos, taken with your iPad, imported from your digital camera, or streamed from other devices. We'll edit your photos, create albums, and share them via email or the Web. Learn how to create slideshows and stream them to your HDTV. Bring your digital camera, take some pictures or videos with your iPad, or we'll use the CLC's computers to get your photos onto your iPad.



Using Dropbox Cloud Services on the iPad: I session

Dropbox is one of the simplest and most elegant ways to store your photos and files in the cloud, and share them amongst your various computers and mobile devices. In this class, we'll be sure you have a free Dropbox account set up, and then see how you can make use of it to automatically back up your photos and, if you want, free up some space on your iPad or your iCloud account. If you've taken the "Photos on the iPad" class, then you'll understand the utility of this app! See how other files can also be synced and shared. Get some experience with using "the cloud" you hear so much about today.

Talking with Siri: I session

If you'd like to have a conversation with your iPad, then this is the course for you. We'll show you how to enable Siri, launch the service, and try it out. Siri is an intelligent personal assistant that exists to allow you to communicate with your mobile device by speaking to "her". You'll teach her about you and your family. We'll offer tips on how to have a successful conversation, and how to recover from misunderstandings. Dictate rather than typing your emails! Get a glimpse into what the future of computer interaction may be!



More email on the iPad: I session

Whether you are relatively new to email, or are a pro surfer on a PC or Mac, we will expand your knowledge and introduce you to many features of the iPad Mail app that you may not be aware of. Using your gmail account as the vehicle, we'll cover setting up your (already-existing) email accounts on the iPad, reading and printing email, opening and saving attachments, sending email and attachments including photos, organizing email using folders or labels, and tuning settings to personalize your email experience.



Music on the iPad: I session

Learn how to rip your CD music to iTunes on your PC, use the music from your PC, or purchase new music. Then sync your music to your iPad, or share it from you computer or iCloud. Learn how to play it on your iPad or wirelessly via AirPlay from your iPad to your HDTV or any speakers in your house connected via Airport Express. Bring a sample CD, or your laptop with music on it, or use the CLC's equipment to see how it all works.



Surfing the Web on the iPad: I session

This class will expand your surfing knowledge and introduce you to many features of the iPad browser that you may not be aware of. Building on the basics of the web covered in the "iPad Basics" course, we'll explore the use of tabs, how to read without distractions, creating a reading list for later off-line reading, saving time with AutoFill, saving or sharing favorite sites, searching the web or a web page, reopening recent web pages, and tuning your browser settings for safety and privacy.



Intro to iOS 7: I session

The new iOS 7 platform for Apple's mobile devices simply makes what you do now easier, faster and more enjoyable. While many apps may look different, the way you do things feels perfectly familiar. Using your iPad, we will explore about a dozen new features including changes to the Photos app, new camera features, the new AirDrop photo and file sharing feature and iTunes Radio as well as quick access to the Control Center and new ways to handle multitasking and to search.
